

**DUAL DEGREE AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
HANBAT NATIONAL UNIVERSITY  
AND  
SCHOOL OF VISUAL ARTS, LLC**

This Dual Degree Agreement (the "Agreement") is made as of April 18, 2018 between Hanbat National University (hereinafter called "HANBAT"), a university having its address at 125 Dongseodaero, Yuseong-gu, Daejeon 305-719, Republic of Korea and School of Visual Arts, LLC. (hereinafter called "SVA"), a university having its address at 209 East 23 Street, New York, NY 10010-3994, U.S.A.

**WHEREAS**

- a) Associate of Fine Arts: Visual Communication Design degree students at HANBAT may seek third year placement in the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) program in Design at SVA.
- b) Both institutions are agreeable to the establishment of a Dual Degree agreement contingent upon the following conditions and areas of agreement.

**1.0 AREAS OF AGREEMENT**

This Agreement is intended to outline a specific course of study for Associate of Fine Arts: Visual Communication Design degree students at HANBAT who may wish to apply to transfer into the third year of the BFA program in Design at SVA, as follows:

- 1.1 Following the review of the HANBAT curriculum, SVA anticipates that HANBAT students who successfully complete 2 years of the course of study for the Associate of Fine Arts: Visual Communication Design degree program at HANBAT, including the humanities and science courses, listed on the attached Course Comparison Chart, will be eligible to apply for transfer into the Bachelor of Fine Arts program in Design at SVA and graduate within two additional years of full-time study.
- 1.2 Students must successfully complete all HANBAT courses listed on the attached Course Comparison Chart, which shows course equivalencies between HANBAT courses and SVA courses that satisfy BFA degree requirements at SVA.
- 1.3 Transferring students must have a minimum 1bt TOEFL score of 80 and a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 at HANBAT. Credits will only be awarded for those courses at HANBAT in which students earn a grade of C or better.
- 1.4 Transfer placement of any student is contingent upon satisfactory review and approval by SVA's admissions office and the Design Department chair, in accordance with

SVA's admissions process, of the student's application, including without limitation the student's portfolio and transfer credits, and is subject to space availability in the program.

1.5 A total of 57 credits may be accepted in transfer as follows: 12 credits in humanities and sciences, and 36 credits in studio and 9 credits in Art History. Students would then be required to complete 18 credits in humanities and sciences and 6 credits in art history, 36 credits in studio, and 3 credits in open studio electives at SVA for the BFA in Design.

1.6 SVA Dual-degree Program recipients from HANBAT must satisfy the graduation requirements of HANBAT in order to finish the SVA program.

This Agreement is not intended to, and does not, create any binding obligations between the parties under the laws of any country or jurisdiction.

## 2.0 CONDITIONS

This Agreement:

2.1 will come into effect upon the signature by the president of HANBAT and the president of SVA;

2.2 will apply for a period of five (5) years—April 18, 2018 to April 18, 2023 unless terminated earlier in accordance with 2.3 that follows;

2.3 may be terminated by either party giving to the other party no less than three (3) months notice in writing.

## 3.0 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY, GOVERNING LAW

In no event shall either party have liability to the other, or to any other person or entity, for any reason whatsoever under this Agreement, and neither party shall be entitled to claim any breach or damages by reason of any action taken, or for any failure to take any action, pursuant to this Agreement. This Agreement shall be governed by the substantive laws of the State of New York, USA, without reference to its conflicts or law rules or any other law that might require the application of the substantive laws of any other jurisdiction.
